Judy and Roy Schache have had their world (and trip to Seattle) turned upside down these past two weeks. Judy will have colon cancer surgery Wednesday, June 26. They say: "It looks like we are not doing our big road trip (although all bookings have been made), and Judy will not be doing any traveling for several weeks. Please say a prayer for Judy and the surgeons next Wednesday morning and then continue to pray that the cancer hasn't spread too far and for a speedy recovery."

Prayers are requested for healing, comfort and strength for **Ed Dicke and Jeanne Dicke**. Ed sustained a brain injury as a result of a fall while on a walk near their home on 4/24. He is home from the hospital and recuperating. He is alert and moving around on his own, but needs to take it easy. Jeanne is undergoing chemo therapy/radiation therapy through mid-September for breast cancer (Stage II B). So far she is tolerating the treatment with minimal side effects.

Former educational missionary, **Ronnie Rivers**, passed away in St Louis on May 1st. 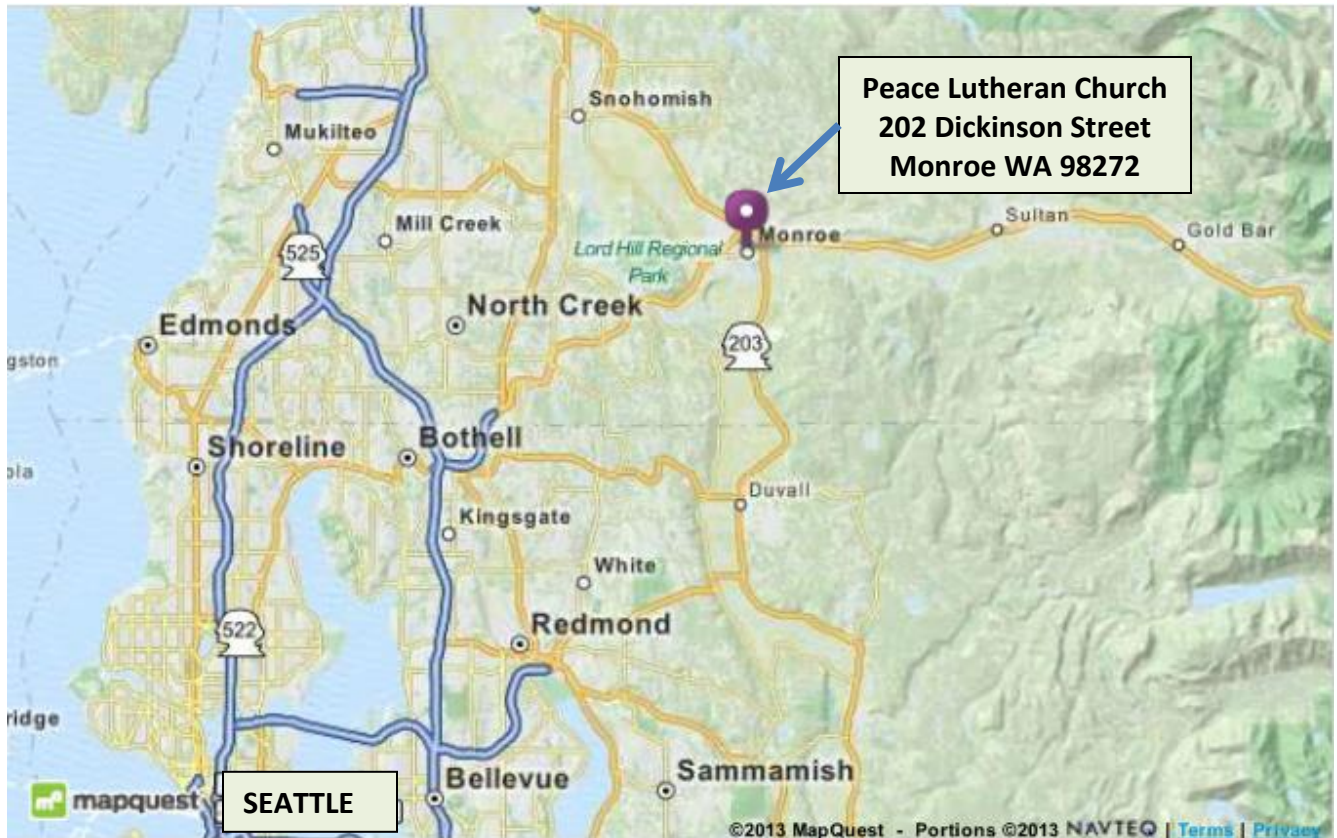
