BOISE "THIRD CULTURE KIDS" BUNG POSTPONED TO 2022 And Other News

Blessings and New Year greetings as we begin 2021. This special issue of the PNGMS Newsletter comes to you with several **announcements** of import.

The first announcement is that due to continuing COVID-19 concerns, the PNGMS Board has decided to postpone the TCK Bung from July 2021 to July 2022. **The new date for the TCK Bung will be July 1- 3, 2022 with the venue remaining in Boise, ID.**

The second announcement goes with the first. **It is a call for all TCKs to write a submission recounting their experiences as Third Culture Kids in preparation for the 2022 Bung.** Two articles, one from Jeanne Dicke and a second from Andrew Luedtke, have already been posted on the new PNGMS website under "TCK Bung 2022." Andrew's article contains a guide to writing submissions with multiple ideas for content. Ruth Van Reken will be our guest speaker at the Bung**, and the board has also decided to extend participation at the Bung by inviting TCKs beyond more traditional PNGMS membership, such as TCK friends of PNGMS members.
